ABOUT MIKHALAI LEARNING CENTRE

Pertubuhan Kebajikan Mikhalai, operating as Mikhalai Learning Centre (MLC), is a registered non-profit organization, approved by the Registrar of Societies on March 10, 2021, under Section 7 of the Societies Act 1966 (Reg No: PPM-010-14-1003202).

Our mission is to uplift underprivileged, stateless, and at-risk children from broken homes by providing them with shelter, daily meals, medical care, and a strong foundation in education.

MLC was established in 2016 by Ms. Mikhalai. Today, it is managed by Ms. Mikhalai and her husband, Steve Sivam, supported by volunteer teachers and a dedicated School Board. During our mission in 2015, we discovered many homeless, abused, and undernourished children, mainly from broken and dysfunctional families. Most lacked valid birth certificates or official identity papers, which prevented them from enrolling in government schools. Tragically, many were even treated as foreigners by government health facilities.

Moved by the plight of these children, Ms. Mikhalai and Steve envisioned a school that could meet their pressing and diverse needs. Thus, MLC began with four students.

Today, we care for 40 students, with more expected to join in late 2025 or early 2026 based on inquiries and recommendations. MLC provides not only meals and medical care but also a dynamic educational curriculum, learning materials, and separate hostel accommodations for boys and girls.

Initially started as a self-supporting multi-racial school using the "O" Level (IGCSE) syllabus, MLC serves children aged 7 to 17. Our primary goal is to eradicate poverty through education and reintegrate these children into society with love, dignity and protection. Our school is located at 435, Jalan Sultan Azlan Shah, Taman Million, 51100 Kuala Lumpur (Wisma Wise).

With increased enrollment and rising expenditures, our resources are stretched to the limit. Nevertheless, we remain steadfast in our mission and our belief that no child shall be turned away.

We have been faithfully supported by generous individuals and business owners over the years.

However, the COVID-19 pandemic has deeply affected many livelihoods, resulting in fewer financial contributions and donations in kind.

As we depend entirely on the generosity of sponsors and well-wishers, your support is crucial in sustaining our operations.

On behalf of the children, all of us at MLC thank you in advance for your kind contributions and for sowing seeds of hope into young lives.

OUR FUTURE PLAN

Today, MLC operates from a rented shoplot for classes, while the boys' and girls' hostels remain in separate rented houses. Looking ahead, our long-term dream is to have a permanent home for MLC — with proper classrooms and safe hostels for the children together in one place.

For now, our focus is on sustaining and strengthening the school today, ensuring every child has stability, care, and quality education as we build toward this vision.


BILLY LERRY S PELAWI

The best thing I did was agree to come to MLC.

The Lord has shown me my intellectual abilities and has given me self-control, but most of all, He has shown me grace...His undying grace.

Through the teachers, interns, and students with whom I was there, I learned what grace is. Here I have built friendships that will last for years. I was encouraged to seize the opportunity to get the education and help I wanted. I believe and became a person that God has intended for me.

Thank you MLC for making my new life in Christ even possible and for giving me a safe haven to grow and to graduate out of school for good. For me, this school has helped me a lot in terms of academics and discipline. I was later sent to Montfort to pursue my study in the automotive field because of my interest in skills.





I'm a boy who didn't have proper care and place to stay. As a young boy without parents, I was 11 years old when I was brought in by some good Samaritans who took pity of me to MLC in 2016.

Before God brought me to MLC, my life was very different from what it is today. I knew little about who I was, or what I wanted to be. Thankfully, God got my attention and allowed me to see that the life I was living was not His plan for me. MLC has become my family. They taught me, corrected me, grown alongside me, laughed and cried with me. I've found out that it's going to be the hardest place to leave when I graduate.



I have been blessed with a wonderful team of teachers who showed love, kindness and care, and I have learned how to show that love with others. I have discovered so much about myself and began to understand who God is. I can say with confidence that I know who I am, and that I stand on a solid foundation. I graduated from MLC in 2019 and pursue my studies at Montfort as a Graphic Designer.

Being a student in MLC was the most wonderful stay of my life. Previously I have faced with problems but relived painful memories, asked for forgiveness, and learned the meaning of obedience before understanding—and I have seen the rewards that come with that hard work.





I decided to leave mainstream Chinese school because I was struggling to cope with the workload and the pace. My parents decided to pull me out of mainstream school when I was 13 years at the time and studying for my Form 1.

When I first arrived at MLC, I was reluctant to change and was unable to do so on my own accord. Lazy, disrespectful, argumentative, these are to name just a few of the flaws. MLC provided a means for a different perspective on my life, a perspective from which I could sort through all the clutters and come out with something slightly resembling a sensible and rational individual. Which is what I would like to think I am today.

MLC helped me realize my potential in school as well as in my ability to succeed in life. I left MLC a completely different person to Montfort. I left as an applied, disciplined, high school graduate. God has taught me the value of patience and perserverance, especially during challenging times. My faith played a significant role in opening my eyes to my capabilities. I graduated from MLC in 2019 and pursue my studies at Montfort in the automotive field.
